1. Welcome Mike Nightingale as Chief Deputy Superintendent effective July 1, 2018.

2. Welcome Tom Hamer as Associate Superintendent effective August 20, 2018.

3. Welcome Rod Swartzenberger as Facility Services Supervisor effective October 1, 2018.

4. Minister of Education David Eggen recognized Palliser School Division for success in the dual credit work and CTS courses offered in its' high school programs.

5. David Shaw, Transportation Supervisor, recently received a perfect rating of 0.00 on its carrier profile issued by Alberta Transportation. We sincerely thank him and his team for safely transporting our students in the Palliser division.

6. Dr. Maurice Hollingsworth made a presentation to the Board on the history of Palliser's involvement in the technology project in Dominica. Palliser will continue to offer assistance in the project.

7.
