- 4. School Board Report: Sharon Rutledge

At the Organizational Meeting held on Sept. 18, 2018 the following were appointed: **Robert Strauss --- Chairman of the Board Deb Laturnus ---- Vice- Chairman Lorelei Bexte ----- Deputy Vice- Chairman**

The enrollment numbers are slightly lower than projected but are expected to rise. The final count is taken on Sept 30, 2018. This number is what the funding from Alberta Education is based on.

The Palliser Education Centre is in need of mechanical & plumbing repair. Out of 6 rooftop units that control the heating and cooling in the building, 3 of them are not working. In early July, there was minor flooding to some offices due to rupture of some of the overhead sprinklers. There is a challenge with the plumbing system in the bathrooms and needs to be repaired to meet the needs of employees and renters in the building. The province allows school divisions to use a small portion of the funds given to be used for administrative proposes. Palliser uses 3.6 % of the total funds for administration. A portion of this money can be used to fund the project.

Palliser Education Centre property west of the building (about 4 acres) has subdivision approval from the City of Lethbridge. The property is suitable for commercial use and will be up for sale. Upgrades to the parking area will be made following the sale and can offset other improvements made at Palliser Education Centre.

Meeting with Coaldale Town Council Plans for a follow-up meeting between Palliser Board of Trustees and Coaldale Town Council will be held on Oct. 16. Discussion will continue about partnership possibilities including Coaldale's offer of property for a new Palliser school/community building and a possible expansion of course offerings for students.

Noble Central School Grand Opening has been proposed to be held on Nov. 15, 2018 at 2:00.

John Davidson & Huntsville Schools are now offering Distance Learning for Grades 10 to 12.

Vulcan Daycare runs a before and after school program at present, but has limited space. The daycare would like to use Vulcan Prairieview Elementary School. A formal agreement will be drawn up to cover items such as what parts of the school will be used and cleaning and supervision issues. It is hoped to have the program open on October 1, 2018.
